Dean Spade is an assistant professor at the Seattle University School of Law, teaching Administrative Law, Poverty Law and Law and Social Movements. In 2002, he founded the Sylvia Rivera Law Project, a collective that provides free legal help to low income people and people of color who are trans, intersex and/or gender non-conforming and works to build trans resistance centered in racial and economic justice. He is the author of Normal Life: Administrative Violence, Critical Trans Politics and the Limits of Law (2011).
